Child poverty rates are typically higher than total poverty rates. Even though Kentucky child poverty rates in 2012 were still higher than the nation, the gap is smaller than in 2007.

The official poverty rates are available through the U. S. Census Bureau's Small Area Income and Poverty Estimates (SAIPE) program.

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
