Since 2007, the number of people below poverty in Kentucky increased from 706,947 (+/- 14,225) to 821,067 (+/-15,075). Even though the recession has officially ended, in Kentucky and nationally, poverty and poverty rates have not declined to pre-recession levels.

While the American Community Survey (ACS) contains estimates with detailed characteristics of those below poverty, county and other local level estimates from the ACS often refer to multiple years.

The <u>official poverty rates</u> are available through the U. S. Census Bureau's Small Area Income and Poverty Estimates (SAIPE) program.

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
