The overall goals for the Community Assessments are:


- To gain a better understanding of the county's pressing issues;


- From 2010 to 2017, the total population in Lyon County decreased by -232 people.<sup>2</sup>
- Between April 2010 and June 2017, there was an estimated net in migration of 195 people.<sup>4</sup>
- In 2016, the composition of Lyon County's population is estimated to be **91.1%** White, **5.0%** Black/African American, **0.4%** Asian, **1.8%** other and 2 or more races, and **1.6%** Hispanic.<sup>5</sup>
- From 2017 to 2025, the total population in Lyon County is projected to increase by 520 people.<sup>3</sup>
- As baby boomers are entering retirement, between 2010 and 2025 the population ages 65 and over in Lyon County are **projected** to **increase** by **37.4%** compared to 51.9% for the state as a whole.<sup>3</sup>



- In 2016, Lyon County's official poverty rate was **16.4%** (13.1% 19.7%), compared to 18.2% (17.9% 18.6%) for the state as a whole.<sup>8</sup>
- In 2017, there were **2** child care centers in Lyon County. Of these **2** were STARS certified.<sup>9</sup>
- Between 2012-2016, 3.7% (+/-1.4%) of people ages 5 and over spoke a language other than English at home.
- The Urban Institute estimates that **14%** people in Lyon County with a credit bureau record in 2016 had student loan debt compared to 16% for the state. <sup>10</sup>

- In 2012, the total market value of agricultural products sold in Lyon County was \$6,782,000.<sup>13</sup>
- Of the total market value of agricultural products sold, **78.0%** was the value of crops and **22.0%** was the value of livestock, poultry, and their products.<sup>13</sup>
- The total farm production expenses (average per farm) was \$37,150 compared to \$62,002 for the state. 13
- In Lyon County, there were 115 hired farm labor workers on 53 farms. 13
- 90.4% of farms were operated by a family or an individual compared to 91.0% for the state.<sup>13</sup>





- In 2017, the number of private establishments covered by unemployment insurance in Lyon County was **30** for goods-producing, **150** for service-providing, and **28** for hospitality & leisure. 18
- Between 2012 and 2016, of the **2,721** (+/- 255) workers ages 16 and over, **44.7%** (+/- 6.8%) worked inside the county, **51.7%** (+/-1.8%) worked outside the county and **3.6%** (+/-1.8%) worked outside Kentucky.<sup>7</sup>
- Between 2012 and 2016, **4.8%** (+/-3.1%) of workers ages 16 and over who worked full-time year round were below poverty compared to 3.5% (+/- 0.1%) for the state as a whole.<sup>7</sup>
- 18.3% of 2016 HS graduates in the county earned an industry certificate compared to 19.2% for the state.<sup>19</sup>

**22.9%** of students entered KY public postsecondary institutions underprepared in one or more subjects (2015).<sup>21</sup>

- Between 2012-2016, there were an estimated 62 (+/-37) youth ages 5-17 who had a disability.
- **38.1%** of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students in Lyon County scored proficient or distinguished on math in the 2015-16 school year compared to 47.7% for the state.<sup>22</sup>
- **216** (+/- 92) youth under age 18 lived in households that received supplemental security income (SSI), cash public assistance, or food stamps/SNAP in the past 12 months (2012-2016).<sup>7</sup>



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- The estimated food insecurity rate for Lyon County is 12.9%, compared to 15.5% for the state.<sup>27</sup>
- From 2010 to 2016, the number of grocery stores did not change by 0.0%, from 1 to 1 stores. 16
- In 2013-2015, 29.3% (22.9%-36.7%) of adults ages 20 and over reported no leisure time physical activity.<sup>24</sup>
- The Urban Institute estimates that 22% of people in Lyon County with a credit bureau record in 2016 had medical debt in collections compared to 27% for the state as a whole. 10
- 5.1% (1.0%-23.1%) of adults reported that there was a time in past year when they needed to see a doctor but could not because of the cost.<sup>25</sup>
