- The estimated food insecurity rate for Meade County is **13.0%**, compared to 15.5% for the state.<sup>27</sup>
- From 2010 to 2016, the number of grocery stores <u>decreased</u> by 33.3%, from 6 to 4 stores.<sup>16</sup>
- In 2013-2015, **27.4%** (22.3%-32.3%) of adults ages 20 and over reported no leisure time physical activity.<sup>24</sup>
- The Urban Institute estimates that 22% of people in Meade County with a credit bureau record in 2016 had medical debt in collections compared to 27% for the state as a whole.<sup>10</sup>
- 15.1% (8.6%-25.1%) of adults reported that there was a time in past year when they needed to see a doctor but could not because of the cost.<sup>25</sup>


- From 2010 to 2017, the total population in Meade County decreased by -448 people.<sup>2</sup>
- In 2016, the composition of Meade County's population is estimated to be 89.4% White, 3.2% Black/African American, 0.7% Asian, 2.8% other and 2 or more races, and 3.9% Hispanic.<sup>5</sup>
- From 2017 to 2025, the total population in Meade County is **projected** to **decrease** by -1,374 people.<sup>3</sup>
- As baby boomers are entering retirement, between 2010 and 2025 the population ages 65 and over in Meade County are **projected** to **increase** by **79.8%** compared to 51.9% for the state as a whole.<sup>3</sup>



In 2016, Meade County's official poverty rate was 13.4% (11.0% - 15.8%), compared to 18.2% (17.9% - 18.6%) for the state as a whole.<sup>8</sup>

- In 2017, there were 11 child care centers in Meade County. Of these 3 were STARS certified.<sup>9</sup>
- Between 2012-2016, **2.7%** (+/-0.8%) of people ages 5 and over spoke a language other than English at home.<sup>7</sup>
- The Urban Institute estimates that 18% people in Meade County with a credit bureau record in 2016 had student loan debt compared to 16% for the state.<sup>10</sup>



In 2012, the total market value of agricultural products sold in Meade County was \$36,571,000.<sup>13</sup>

- Of the total market value of agricultural products sold, 51.7% was the value of crops and 48.3% was the value of livestock, poultry, and their products.<sup>13</sup>
- The total farm production expenses (average per farm) was **\$47,842** compared to \$62,002 for the state.<sup>13</sup>
- In Meade County, there were **491** hired farm labor workers on **165** farms.<sup>13</sup>
- 92.8% of farms were operated by a family or an individual compared to 91.0% for the state.<sup>13</sup>




