

- The estimated food insecurity rate for Whitley County is 17.4%, compared to 15.5% for the state.²⁷
- From 2010 to 2016, the number of grocery stores <u>decreased</u> by 20.0%, from 15 to 12 stores. 16
- In 2013-2015, **36.0%** (30.5%-41.5%) of adults ages 20 and over reported no leisure time physical activity.²⁴
- The Urban Institute estimates that 34% of people in Whitley County with a credit bureau record in 2016 had medical debt in collections compared to 27% for the state as a whole.¹⁰
- 20.2% (13.2%-29.6%) of adults reported that there was a time in past year when they needed to see a doctor but could not because of the cost.²⁵



- From 2010 to 2017, the total population in Whitley County increased by 577 people.²
- Between April 2010 and June 2017, there was an estimated **net out migration** of **-148** people.⁴
- In 2016, the composition of Whitley County's population is estimated to be 96.0% White, 0.8% Black/African American, **0.5%** Asian, **1.5%** other and 2 or more races, and **1.2%** Hispanic.⁵
- From 2017 to 2025, the total population in Whitley County is projected to decrease by -537 people.³
- As baby boomers are entering retirement, between 2010 and 2025 the population ages 65 and over in Whitley County are projected to increase by 19.6% compared to 51.9% for the state as a whole.3



- In 2016, Whitley County's official poverty rate was 29.3% (24.3% 34.3%), compared to 18.2% (17.9% 18.6%) for the state as a whole.⁸
- In 2017, there were **14** child care centers in Whitley County. Of these **10** were STARS certified.⁹



- In 2012, the total market value of agricultural products sold in Whitley County was \$5,382,000.¹³
- Of the total market value of agricultural products sold, **31.4%** was the value of crops and **68.6%** was the value of livestock, poultry, and their products.¹³
- The total farm production expenses (average per farm) was \$16,504 compared to \$62,002 for the state. 13
- In Whitley County, there were 184 hired farm labor workers on 91 farms.¹³
- 92.5% of farms were operated by a family or an individual compared to 91.0% for the state. 13


- In 2017, the number of private establishments covered by unemployment insurance in Whitley County was **71** for goods-producing, **712** for service-providing, and **72** for hospitality & leisure.¹⁸
- Between 2012 and 2016, of the **12,177** (+/- 689) workers ages 16 and over, **68.4%** (+/- 3.6%) worked inside the county, **28.5%** (+/-1.1%) worked outside the county and **3.1%** (+/-1.1%) worked outside Kentucky.⁷
- Between 2012 and 2016, **4.3%** (+/-1.5%) of workers ages 16 and over who worked full-time year round were below poverty compared to 3.5% (+/- 0.1%) for the state as a whole.⁷
- 13.7% of 2016 HS graduates in the county earned an industry certificate compared to 19.2% for the state. 19

24.1% of students entered KY public postsecondary institutions underprepared in one or more subjects (2015).²¹

- Between 2012-2016, there were an estimated 557 (+/-195) youth ages 5-17 who had a disability.
- **50.2%** of 3rd grade students in Whitley County scored proficient or distinguished on math in the 2015-16 school year compared to 47.7% for the state.²²
- **3,908** (+/- 563) youth under age 18 lived in households that received supplemental security income (SSI), cash public assistance, or food stamps/SNAP in the past 12 months (2012-2016).⁷
