Finding Subject Tables from the American Community Survey using the American FactFinder Website

Subject Tables are one place where commonly used estimates from the American Community Survey can be located. The Subject Tables are also useful in that they provide both estimates and well as pre-calculated percents.

This publication provides graphical instructions to help you find Subject Tables from the American Community Survey using the American FactFinder website.

The American FactFinder website from the U.S. Census Bureau provides online access to several data sources including the 2010 Census and the American Community Survey.

To help in locating data, the website provides filters to help narrow your search. These filters can be used in any order and in any combination.



1. The most direct way to locate data for your county is to begin with the **“QUICK START”** box.


2. Type your county name. (I'll use Mercer County.)

As you type, a list will appear with all of the geographies possible that contain your county's name. Select the one that is your county.



1. Since I want the Mercer County that is in Kentucky, that's what I picked.

2. Click **“GO”**



The results are always organized to show you:
the Table ID, the Table Title,
and the Dataset the table came from.

This box *always* shows you which filters you picked.
So far, we have only picked Mercer County, Kentucky.
