Geography Comparison Tables are one way to find pre-calculated percents (%), rates, means and medians from the American Community Survey on a variety of topics for <u>every county</u> in Kentucky in a <u>single table</u>.

The American FactFinder website from the U.S. Census Bureau provides online access to several data sources including the 2010 Census and the American Community Survey. This publication provides graphical instructions to help you make Geography Comparison Tables from the American Community Survey, but the same process can be used for other datasets.
