

Data Availability from the American Community Survey

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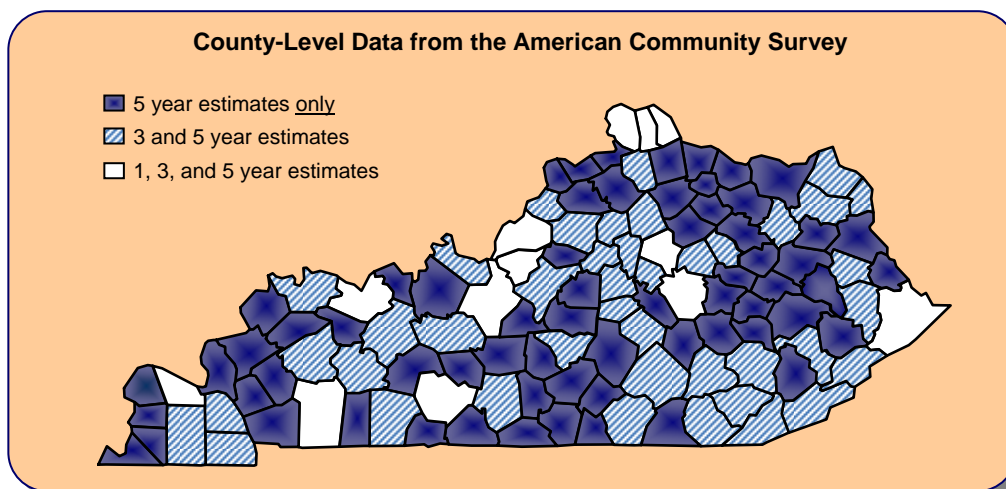


Three types of estimates are released each year from the American Community Survey: 1-, 3-, and 5-year estimates.

Which estimates are available for your county, depends on the size of your county.

(The 5-year estimates are the only estimates that are comparable across all counties.)

(Populations of less than 20,000 persons)
